INTRODUCTION

The Church is most fully the Church when its gathers together in the worship of God through Christ around the Word and the Sacraments. Since the beginning of the Church, between each celebration of the Lord's Supper, Christians have marked the passing of time between each Lord Day with the praying of psalms and reading from Holy Scripture — a way of prayer without ceasing. (1 Thessalonians 5:17) Work, family, responsibilities, and health do not always allow our faith communities to gather in prayer as often as we should. A common liturgical calendar, lectionary, and prayer life allows us to more fully live as the *one* Church of Christ — whether we are gathered in church or scattered throughout the world.

Here you will find a liturgical calendar giving dates and readings for Sundays, Festivals, and Commemorations; a daily outline of thematic Bible readings based on the three-year Revised Common Lectionary; and an order of psalms for morning and evening based on the Lutheran Book of Worship calendar as modified and expanded in Philip Pfatteicher's Daily Prayer of the Church. The liturgical color of the day is given (gold=white), and days on which it is especially appropriate to gather in celebration of the Eucharist are highlighted in bold print. On Sundays and Festivals, the readings given here are the ones used in the celebration of the Eucharist, rather than those appointed to daily prayer. (Liturgical colors and observation of some feast days will vary from this calendar by local use.)

In order to follow along in prayer and study with the use of this booklet, one will also need to have a Bible on hand (or online access, such as at bible.oremus.org). The New Revised Standard Version (NRSV) is the translation of the Bible generally used in Lutheran churches. The psalms may be prayed from the Bible or from the translation one's congregation uses in worship (e.g., Lutheran Book of Worship or Book of Common Prayer). Simplified versions of Morning and Evening Prayer are provided in the front section of this booklet, which may be prayed privately or with others, using the readings and psalms provided.

For all who are in danger, sorrow, or any kind of trouble; for those who minister to the sick, the friendless, and the needy; for the peace and unity of the Church of God; for all who proclaim the Gospel, and all who seek the Truth; for bishops, pastors, and deacons; for all who serve God in his Church; for the special needs and concerns of this congregation; for those who have died.

Prayers of thanksgiving for the faithful departed may include those commemorated on the church's calendar (see following pages).

Prayers conclude:

Daily Calendar, Readings, and Psalms

Key

Day/Commemoration: Lists Sundays, Festivals, and Commemorations. Days on which it is especially appropriate to celebrate Holy Communion (excluding Good Friday) are listed in bold print.

Readings: Scripture readings are listed for each day. Sundays and Festivals list the appointed readings and psalm for the Eucharist. Other days list readings from the ELW lectionary which complement the lessons of the nearest Sunday.

Two psalms are appointed for morning and two for evening and follow a cycle that ranges from one to four weeks according to season, though the second psalms for morning and evening tend to repeat more often.
